



FACT SHEET

Nevis, in the Leeward Islands of the Northeast Caribbean, is two miles south of its sister island St. Kitts. Nisbet Plantation Beach Club sits on the north shore of Nevis along its own half-mile stretch of white coral sand beach.

Renowned as the Caribbean's only historic plantation inn located directly on a beach, Nisbet was voted #3 "Best Caribbean Resorts" in *Condé Nast Traveler* Readers' Choice Awards in 2007 and one of the "World's Best Places to Stay in the Americas" by the readers of *Condé Nast Traveler* in 2005.

Nisbet Plantation's beautifully-restored Great House, which dates from 1778, and its 36 charming cottages with all modern conveniences are set in 30 acres of lush tropical foliage. A broad lawn, flanked by stately royal palm trees, sweeps down from the Great House to a half-mile-long white sand beach. A favorite of honeymooners and other lovers, Nisbet Plantation has been called "one of the most romantic resorts in the Caribbean" by TheKnot.com

Cottages

All 36 accommodations are discreetly nestled throughout the property's tropical gardens.

- 6 Upper Premier Junior Suites are housed in three two-story buildings with spacious bedroom and living room areas, larger bathrooms with tub, bar area, and open balconies facing the sea.
- 6 Lower Deluxe Junior Suites with spacious bedroom and living room areas, larger bathrooms with tub, bar area, and open patios facing the sea.
- 10 Deluxe Garden Suites (in five semi-detached cottages), each offer a full bedroom, a spacious bathroom with tub, separate inviting living room, and patio. Deluxe Garden Suites offer either king size or twin beds and an additional queen size-sofa bed in the separate living room area.
- 14 Superior Rooms are housed in seven semi-detached cottages with a spacious bedroom, bathroom with shower, and screened patio.

All cottages are air-conditioned and have ceiling fans. Amenities include: twice daily maid service including evening turndown; telephone; hair dryer; tea and coffee makers; full complement of bathroom amenities; iron and board; bathrobes; in-room safes; and mini-bars (can be pre-stocked with guests' preferences on advance request).

Guests who choose to stay connected to the outside world will find cable television and wireless access available in the Great House lounge. Our reception area offers a computer station with complimentary Internet access also.

Dining

- Full breakfast is served year-round at Nisbet's poolside restaurant, Coconuts, with the magnificent Atlantic Ocean providing a splendid backdrop. In-room Continental breakfast is available.
- Nisbet Plantation's Great House is the focal point of the property, commanding an awe-inspiring view of the magnificent grounds. Guests enjoy a three-course dinner. Fresh Fish is a nightly feature and is accompanied by an assortment of flavorful appetizers, soups and salads. An intimate dinner concludes with an after dinner drink in the Great House lounge.
- Occasional dinners (such as the weekly beach barbecue) are served at Coconuts.
- Lunch is served a la carte daily at the Sea Breeze Beach Bar, although not included in MAP rates.
- Afternoon Tea is served daily from 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM.

AMENITIES

Swimming Pool

The resort offers a freshwater swimming pool, hot tub and newly expanded sundeck located directly on the beach.

The Palms Spa

The redesigned, newly-reopened Palms Spa at Nisbet Plantation offers an array of massages and therapeutic bodywork. Massages also can be offered in the privacy of your room.

Fitness Centre

The resort's new fitness centre offers Cybex equipment including – a recumbent cycle; arc trainer; treadmill; and York Barbell free weights, as well as a television to watch while exercising.

Sports

Guest can enjoy complimentary use of snorkeling equipment; tennis court with racquets and balls; bocce; horseshoes; and croquet – *island style*. In addition to the on-property activities, guests have a host of off-property activities that can be arranged through the Front Desk. We can arrange watersports including – Scuba diving; sport fishing; catamaran; snorkeling trips; windsurfing; and parasailing and land sports including – horseback riding; hiking; bicycling; eco-tours; plantation tours; island tours; trips to the Botanical Gardens; star-gazing programs; and golf at Nevis' own the Robert Trent Jones Jr. championship golf course.

Weekly Manager's Rum Punch Party

On Thursday evenings, join General Managers Glen and Erin Hurd's rum Punch Party. Afterwards, you can relax under the stars next to swimming pool and grill where our team of chefs prepares shrimp; grouper; blue marlin; mahi mahi; steak; and more, right before your eyes. Throughout the evening guests will be entertained by the rhythms of a local West Indian band.

Treasures Gift Shop

Located in the Reception building, Treasures offers small gift items; postcards; t-shirts; golf shirts; hats; soft drinks; snacks; and assorted sundries.

Dry Cleaning and Laundry Service

The resort will gladly arrange laundry service. Dry cleaning service is not available on the island.

Babysitting

Babysitting can be arranged through the Front Desk.

Children

Families are welcome at Nisbet Plantation Beach Club. Children under 8 years can be served dinner at 6:00pm in the Great House or special arrangements can be made.

Picnic Lunches

These can be prepared for guests who are planning picnics, fishing trips, or other off-site diversions. Please allow 24 hours advance notice.

Church Services

The island of Nevis boasts over 50 churches including Anglican, Catholic, Methodist, and other denominations. Transportation can be arranged a day in advance.

Electricity

110 volt, AC 60 cycles (as in North America).

Car Rental & Taxi Service

Car and Jeep rentals can be arranged through the Front Desk. A valid National Driver's License will be required to receive a temporary Nevisian license for about EC\$65 or (US\$25). Taxis are available at all times.

Dress Code

Summer clothing and cover ups in the restaurant areas are recommended during the day. During the evening, smart casual attire – dress long pants and collared shirts – is required in the Great House after 6:00 PM.

Method of Payment

American Express, MasterCard, and Visa are accepted. Most island shops and restaurants accept credit cards.

Arrival & Departure

Check-in is at 3:00 PM. Arrangements may be made to accommodate early arrivals. Check-out is at 12:00 PM (noon) with complimentary courtesy changing rooms available for late departures.

Currency

All charges at Nisbet Plantation are shown in US dollar. The local currency is the Eastern Caribbean Dollar (EC\$) – approximate exchange rate: US\$1 = EC\$2.65. Most businesses on the island accept both currencies.

Immigration

It is recommended that all visitors bring valid passports to facilitate entry and return home. As of December 31, 2005, a valid U.S. passport is required by law for U.S. citizens seeking reentry to the U.S. from Nevis. Departure Tax is about EC\$60 or US \$22 payable in cash, or by credit card, at the airport.
